(3) <a href="#">Maintain an up-to-date problem list of current and active diagnoses.</a>	AVAILABLE
(4) <a href="#">Generate and transmit permissible prescriptions electronically (eRx).</a>	AVAILABLE
(5) <a href="#">Maintain active medication list.</a>	AVAILABLE
(6) <a href="#">Maintain active medication allergy list.</a>	AVAILABLE
(7) <a href="#">Record all of the following demographics:</a> (A) Preferred language (B) Gender (C) Race (D) Ethnicity (E) Date of birth	AVAILABLE
(8) <a href="#">Record and chart changes in the following vital signs:</a> (A) Height (B) Weight (C) Blood pressure (D) Calculate and display body mass index (BMI) (E) Plot and display growth charts for children 2–20 years, including BMI	AVAILABLE
(9) <a href="#">Record smoking status for patients 13 years old or older.</a>	AVAILABLE
(10) <a href="#">Report ambulatory clinical quality measures to CMS, or in the case of Medicaid EPs, the States. (No longer core objective but still required)</a>	AVAILABLE
(11) Implement one <a href="#">clinical decision support rule</a> relevant to specialty or high clinical priority along with the ability to track compliance with that rule.	AVAILABLE
(12) Provide patients with an <a href="#">electronic copy of their health information</a> (including diagnostic test results, problem list, medication lists, medication allergies) upon request.	AVAILABLE
(13) <a href="#">Provide clinical summaries for patients for each office visit.</a>	AVAILABLE

(14) <a href="#">Protect electronic health information</a> created or maintained by the certified EHR technology through the implementation of appropriate technical capabilities.	AVAILABLE
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Eligible Professional Menu Objectives	
(1) <a href="#">Implement drug formulary checks.</a>	AVAILABLE
(2) <a href="#">Incorporate clinical lab-test results into EHR</a> as structured data.	AVAILABLE
(3) Generate <a href="#">lists of patients</a> by specific conditions to use for quality improvement, reduction of disparities, research, or outreach.	AVAILABLE
(4) Send <a href="#">patient reminders</a> per patient preference for preventive/follow-up care.	AVAILABLE
(5) Provide patients with <a href="#">timely electronic access to their health information</a> (including lab results, problem list, medication lists, and allergies) within 4 business days of the information being available to the EP.	AVAILABLE
(6) Use certified EHR technology to identify <a href="#">patient-specific education resources</a> and provide those resources to the patient if appropriate.	AVAILABLE
(7) The EP who receives a patient from another setting of care or provider of care or believes an encounter is relevant should perform <a href="#">medication reconciliation</a> .	AVAILABLE
(8) The EP who transitions their patient to another setting of care or provider of care or refers their patient to another provider of care should provide <a href="#">summary care record</a> for each transition of care or referral.	AVAILABLE
(9) Capability to submit <a href="#">electronic data to immunization registries</a> or immunization information systems and actual submission according to applicable law and practice.	AVAILABLE
